Port Douglas

Port Douglas is just an hour's drive north of Cairns and is the place where glittering green merges into blue; the only place on Earth where two World Heritage listed jewels exist; the Great Barrier Reef and the rainforests of Daintree and Cape Tribulation.

From \$78 p.p. per night
 345 rooms. Set on tropical gardens in the suburb of Manunda, 5 km from the city centre, this resort has 3 lagoon swimming pool and 2 restaurants and combines the tranquility of a tropical resort with the advantages of a mainstream hotel.
