DAY 3 KIEV · LVIV

Breakfast. Visit of the Museum of World War II and of Kiev-Pecherskaya Lavra cave Monastery. Dinner and transfer to the station for your train to Lviv. Overnight on board. (B/D)

DAY 4 LVIV

Arrival in Lviv and transfer to your hotel. City tour including St. George's Cathedral, High Castle Hill and open air Architecture Museum. After lunch, walking tour to discover Svobody Prospekt, Poets Monuments, Latin Cathedral, Armenian Cathedral and flea market. Dinner at your hotel. (B/D)

Breakfast. Visit St. Elizabeth Cathedral, Solomiya Krushchynska House Museum and Lychakivskiy Cemetery. Dinner and transfer to the station for your train to Odessa. Overnight on board. (B/D)

Upon arrival in Odessa, city tour including Tolstoy Palace, Abaza Palace and the Catacombs. Dinner at your hotel. (B/D)
