Wander through colonial cities that echo the legacy of Spanish conquistadors, explore the ancient Inca capital of Cuzco, and visit the lost city of Machu Picchu. The beautiful Peruvian Andes are also home to indigenous highlanders, who still speak the ancient tongue of Quechua and live a traditional way of life.

**Day 1 Lima** • Arrive in Lima and transfer to your hotel.  
*Hotel: José Antonio / Sol de Oro Miraflores (2 nights)*

**Day 2 Lima** • In the morning, enjoy a city tour of Lima, capital of Peru. Visit includes the Cathedral, the convent of San Francisco and the museum of colonial art. Afterwards, take in a panoramic view of the Main Square with the Government Palace and the Municipal Hall. (B)

**Day 3 Lima • Arequipa** • Transfer to the airport for your flight to Arequipa. In the afternoon, take a city tour that includes the Santa Catalina Convent, the Church Cloisters of the Company, the Main Square, the Complex of San Francisco, the Cathedral and finally, the Spanish Colonial district of Yanahuara.  
*Hotel: Sonesta Posada del Inca / Libertador Arequipa (B)*

**Day 4 Arequipa • Colca** • Journey to one of the deepest canyons in the world – “The Colca” – where you will have the opportunity to see the majestic Andean Condor. In the afternoon, visit the village of Chivay or enjoy La Calera thermo-medical baths.  
*Hotel: Casa Andina Colca / Colca Lodge (B/L/D)*

**Day 5 Colca • Puno** • Departure to the “Cruz del Cóndor” viewpoint, the most strategic area to see the Colca Canyon and the flight of the Condors. Afterwards, continue on to observe the pre-Inca tombs and stop in the villages of Pinchollo, Yanque, Cabanaconde, Coporaque and the amphitheatre of Ocolle. Overnight next to Lake Titicaca.  
*Hotel: Casa Andina Private Collection / Libertador Esteves (2 nights) (B/L)*

**Day 6 Puno** • Full day visit to the Floating Islands of Lake Titicaca. The Uros are the original inhabitants of these floating islands and continue to practice their ancient traditions and customs. Afterwards, you will make your way to the unique island of Taquile. The indigenous community that lives here, around 350 families, are descendants of the Incas. (B/L)

**Day 7 Puno • Cuzco** • Morning transfer to board a local bus to the city of Cuzco. On route, you will pass by the villages of Andahuayllillas, Racchi and Pucará. Late afternoon arrival and transfer to the hotel. *Hotel: Casa Andina Plaza Cuzco / Novotel (4 nights) (B/L)*

**Day 8 Cuzco • Sacred Valley • Cuzco** • Full day visit to the Sacred Valley of the Incas. Visit the old Inca Community of Pisac with its traditional and colourful local market. Afterwards, you will visit the Inca temple of Ollantaytambo. (B/L)

**Day 9 Cuzco • Machu Picchu • Cuzco** • Early this morning, transfer to your train for a visit of the sanctuary of Machu Picchu. The spectacular train journey crosses valleys, mountains and typical communities. The citadel was built on a very unique location covered in vegetation between two mountains: the Machu Picchu and Huayna Picchu. Return to Cuzco in the afternoon. (B)

**Day 10 Cuzco** • Afternoon city tour including Koricancha’s Temple, the Cathedral and the archeological sites of Sacsayhuaman, Kenko, Puca Pucara and Tambomachay Temple, also called “Baths of the Incas”. (B)

**Day 11 Cuzco • Lima** • Transfer to the airport for flight back to Lima. Transfer to the hotel for your day use room. In the evening, transfer to Lima airport. (B)
