Train • The trains travel comfortably and securely during the night to the next stop on the itinerary. Each train carries a fleet of air-conditioned Mercedes Benz touring vehicles with professional guides on board who are ready to take guests on inclusive scheduled tours to experience the unique sights of the area. Each train has its own bar, dining and accommodation carriages. As in any hotel, bedding and towels are provided and cabins are serviced daily.

Accommodation Ivory Cabin : Twin beds with fan, safe, hand basin and running water. Shared bathroom facilities. There is one shower and two toilets per carriage.

Gold & Commodore: Twin beds with private bathroom, air-conditioning and safe.

Emerald: twin or double beds with private bathroom, small lounge area, air-conditioning, safe and hairdryer.

The world-renowned Kruger National Park offers a wildlife experience that ranks with the best in Africa. Established in 1898 to protect the wildlife of the South African Lowveld, this national park of nearly 2 million hectares is unrivalled in its diversity.

Day 1 Johannesburg • Welcome to Johannesburg! Upon arrival at Johannesburg airport you will be welcome and transferred to your hotel. *Hotel: Garden Court Sandton City*

Day 2 Johannesburg • Morning at leisure. In the afternoon, enjoy a city tour. Visits of the historical buildings of downtown Johannesburg, passing Hillbrow and the landmark Post Office tower en route. Other sights include: the "Top of Africa" at the Carlton Centre, Brixton Tower the Nelson Mandela Bridge in Newtown and a fully guided tour of Constitution Hill - home of South Africa's new Constitutional Court and site of Johannesburg's Old Fort Prison. *Hotel: Garden Court Sandton City (B)*

Day 3 Johannesburg • Kruger National Park • You will be picked up from your Johannesburg hotel and head east via Nelspruit and Hazyview to spectacular Mpumalanga – "Place Where The Sun Rises". Enter the world-famous Kruger National Park and spend the afternoon game viewing in an open safari vehicle. This adventure accentuates an authentic African Safari experience from start to finish. Return to the hotel as the dinner drum sounds and enjoy dinner under the stars in a traditional African Boma (weather permitting). *Hotel: Protea Kruger Gate or similar (B/D)*

Day 4 Kruger National Park • Early morning breakfast before experiencing the breathtaking Panorama Route, including Bourke's Luck potholes, Blyde River Canyon, God's Window and Lisbon waterfall. Return to the lodge in time for lunch (own account) and spend the remainder of the day at leisure around the pool or viewing deck overlooking the Sabie River. Dinner and overnight at the lodge. *Hotel: Protea Kruger Gate or similar (B/D)*

Day 5 Kruger National Park • Johannesburg • After an early morning game viewing return to the hotel for breakfast. Drive to Johannesburg. Arrival in the early evening. (B)
