Day 1 Delhi - Arrive • Arrive Delhi's Indira Gandhi International Airport where you will be met by our local representative and transferred to your hotel. *Hotel: Svelte or similar*

Day 2 Delhi • Breakfast. Today, visit Old and New Delhi. In Old Delhi, visit the Red Fort, Raj Ghat, the memorial site of Mahatma Gandhi, Jama Masjid, the largest mosque in India. After lunch visit New Delhi: visits will include two monuments from Delhi's past: Humayun's Tomb and Qutub Minar. Drive along the ceremonial avenue Rajghat past the imposing India Gate and Parliament house. *Hotel: Svelte (B/L/D)*

Day 3 Delhi – Varanasi • Breakfast. Transfer to the airport for your flight to Varanasi, situated along the holy river Ganges, the religious centre of Hindu religion. Arrive and transfer to your hotel. *Hotel: Clarks*

Day 4 Varanasi • Early this morning depart around 05:30 for an early morning boat ride on the holy River Ganges. See Varanasi come alive along the banks of the river. Witness people bathing in the holy water and worshipping the rising sun. After the boat ride return to the hotel for breakfast. After breakfast, a city tour will include driving through the Benaras Hindu University with a visit to the Bharat Mata (Mother India) Temple. In the afternoon, visit Sarnath, the birthplace of Buddhism. *Hotel: Clarks (B/L/D)*

Day 5 Varanasi – Khajuraho • Breakfast. Transfer to the airport for your flight to Khajuraho, famously know for its carvings influenced by "Kama Sutra". Visit the world famous temples built by the Chandela kings between 950 AD and 1050 AD. *Hotel: Holiday Inn (B/L/D)*

Day 6 Khajuraho – Orcha – Jhansi - Agra • Breakfast. Depart by car to Jhansi via Orcha. Visit Orcha, a world heritage site, and continue to Jhansi for your train to Agra. Arrive in Agra and transfer to your hotel *Hotel: Clarks Shiraz (B/L/D)*

Day 7 Agra – Fatehpur Sikri – Jaipur • Breakfast. This morning visit the monument of love, Taj Mahal, built by an emperor in memory of his beloved queen. Also visit Agra Fort and the city. Depart for Jaipur. Stop along the way at Fatehpur Sikri, a deserted red sandstone city that was built by Emperor Akbar as his capital. Arrive in Jaipur and transfer to your hotel. *Hotel: Country Inn (B/L/D)*

Day 8 Jaipur • Breakfast. Known as the "Pink City", Jaipur is the capital of the state of Rajasthan. Visit Amber Fort, an example of Rajput architecture. In the afternoon, visit the City Palace Museum and the awe inspiring Jantar Mantar, an observatory dating back to 1726 AD, and finally the Palace of Winds. *Hotel: Country Inn (B/L/D)*

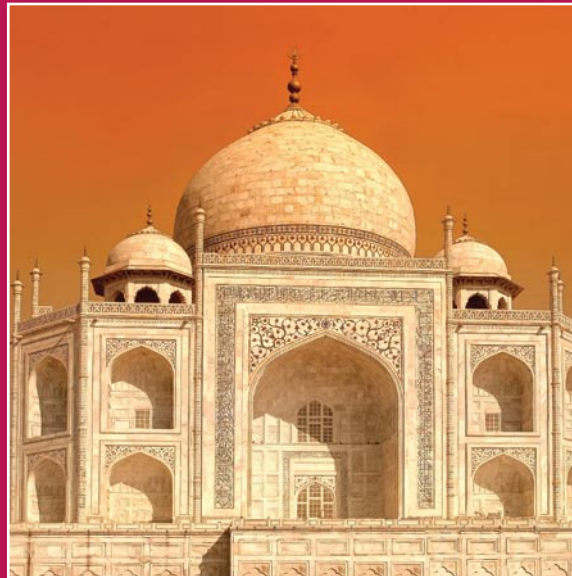
Day 9 Jaipur - Udaipur • Breakfast. Transfer to the airport for your flight to Udaipur, one of the most romantic cities in Rajasthan. Arrive and transfer to your hotel. In the afternoon, boat ride on Lake Pichola *Hotel: Trident Hilton (B/L/D)*

Day 10 Udaipur • Breakfast. Visit the old city, the City Palace Museum overlooking the lake and the Jagdish Temple. *Hotel: Trident Hilton (B/L/D)*

Day 11 Udaipur - Mumbai • Breakfast. Transfer to airport for your flight to Mumbai. Arrive and transfer to your hotel. *Hotel: Fariyas (B/L/D)*

Day 12 Mumbai • Breakfast. Begin with a morning cruise to Elephanta Island with its magnificent caves and, sculptures. After lunch, a visit to the India's Gate, the Prince of Wales Museum, Jehangir Art Gallery, Chowpatty Beach and Hanging Gardens of Malabar Hill and the Crawford Market. *Hotel: Fariyas (B/L/D)*
