Brazil has become one of the most exciting destinations in South America. Its carnivals, the famed beaches of Copacabana and Ipanema, Iguacu Falls, and baroque-style churches in Salvador da Bahia, are just some of the highlights you will visit. Welcome to the country of Samba!

Day 1 Iguacu • Upon arrival in Iguacu you will be met and transferred to your hotel. The rest of the day is at leisure.
Hotel: Grand Mercure / Bourbon Cataratas (2 nights)

Day 2 Iguacu • In the morning, start your visit of the Argentinean side of the falls. Walk along the elevated upper and lower trails and see more than 275 falls and admire the flora and fauna. Continue by train to the Devil's Throat, one of the planet's most spectacular views. Then visit the falls from the Brazilian side, walking along a path that brings you to the rim of the falls for a fascinating view. (B)

Day 3 Iguacu • Salvador De Bahia • Transfer to the airport for your flight to Salvador de Bahia, Brazil's old capital, renowned for its carnival and historic sites. Arrival and transfer to the hotel. (B)
Hotel: Pestana Bahia / Zank Boutique Hotel (2 nights)

Day 4 Salvador De Bahia • Morning visit to Salvador's historic centre and the main points of interest of this ancient yet modern city. In the evening, experience the charm of Brazilian rhythm during the "Bahia by Night" dinner show. (B/D)

Day 5 Salvador De Bahia • Manaus • Transfer to the airport for your flight to Manaus. Upon arrival you will be met and transferred to your hotel. (B)
Hotel: Tropical Manaus (1 night)

Day 6 Manaus • Amazon Rainforest • This morning starts with a guided tour of Manaus main points of interest: the Opera House, the market and the Indian museum. In the afternoon, transfer to the pier. A short visit to the "Meeting of the Waters" by boat is followed by a transfer to the Amazon Ecopark Jungle Lodge, located in the heart of the Amazon forest. Check-in and welcome drink. Tonight's highlight is an evening tour by canoe for a chance to spot alligators. (B/D)
Hotel: Amazon EcoPark (2 nights)

Day 7 Amazon Rainforest • This morning's breakfast is followed by a guided nature hike. After lunch enjoy a jungle excursion to discover the Amazonian flora and fauna, followed by visit to the home of local Amazonians with an opportunity to go fishing. Return to your lodge for dinner. (B/L/D)

Day 8 Amazon Rainforest • Manaus • Following breakfast today visit the "Forest of Monkeys". Return to Manaus by boat and transfer to your hotel. Rest of the day at leisure. (B)
Hotel: Tropical Manaus (1 night)

Day 9 Manaus • Rio de Janeiro • Transfer to the airport for your flight to Rio de Janeiro. Upon arrival you will be met and transferred to your hotel. (B)
Hotel: Excelsior Copacabana / JW Marriott (4 nights)

Day 10 Rio De Janeiro • Morning departure for Praia Vermelha (red beach) and climb the Sugar Loaf, symbol of Rio, by cable car. Proceed downtown, crossing the beautiful Flamengo Park. (B)

Day 11 Rio De Janeiro • Today a visit of Rio de Janeiro, including the Corcovado, where you can admire the statue of Christ. Dinner in a local "Churrasqueria" restaurant. Enjoy a typical Brazilian BBQ followed by a samba show at the famous Plataforma theatre. (B/D)

Day 12 Rio De Janeiro • Day at leisure. (B)

Day 13 Rio De Janeiro • Transfer to the airport of Rio de Janeiro. (B)
