Day 1 Johannesburg • Upon arrival in Johannesburg you will be met and transferred to your hotel.

Hotel: Peermont Metcourt or similar

Day 2 Johannesburg • Hazyview • Leave Johannesburg along the Panorama Route via Graskop, visiting the viewing sites of the Blyde River Canyon, one of the natural wonders of Africa, God's Window and Bourke's Luck Potholes before heading to Hazyview. (B/D)

Hotel: Hippo Hollow or similar (2 nights)

Day 3 Hazyview • Kruger National Park • Hazyview • Full day game viewing in order to enjoy the wonders of exploring the Kruger National Park in your closed vehicle. The Kruger National Park is an internationally renowned game reserve of nearly 2 million hectares and supports the largest variety of wildlife species on the African continent. (B)

Optional (\$): Open safari vehicle game drive. Reservation and payment at destination.

Day 4 Hazyview • Swaziland • Depart on your journey to Swaziland. Visit the famous Ngwenya Glass Factory before arriving at the hotel. (B)

Hotel: Lugogo Sun or similar

Day 5 Swaziland • St Lucia • Depart towards the region of KwaZulu-Natal where ancient traditions and modern cultures have combined into a vibrant society living in peace and harmony. Afternoon at leisure. (B)

Hotel: Elephant Lake or similar

Optional (\$): Sundowner cruise on St Lucia Lake with the opportunity of sighting many hippos, crocodiles and bird life. Reservation and payment at destination.

Day 6 St Lucia • Durban • Departure towards Durban. On arrival, city centre orientation tour and visit of the Botanical Garden. (B/D)

Hotel: Tropicana or similar

Optional (\$): Early morning open safari vehicle game drive in Hluhluwe-Umfolozi Park.

Day 7 Durban • Drakensberg • Head into the majestic Southern Drakensberg Mountains where you will visit the Howick Falls. Arriving at the hotel mid-afternoon. (B/D)

Hotel: Drakensberg Gardens or similar (2 nights)

Day 8 Drakensberg • Full day at leisure. (B/D)

Optional (\$): 4x4 Adventure tour up Sani Pass and into Lesotho (passport required). Reservation and payment at destination.

Day 9 Drakensberg • East London • Departure towards East London with a stop in Umtata, where Nelson Mandela was born and grew up. Visit of the museum that is dedicated to his life and achievements. (B)

Hotel: Kennaway or similar

Day 10 East London • Port Elizabeth • Short orientation tour of East London. Continue towards Grahamstown and visit the 1820 Settler Memorial before continuing onto Port Elizabeth. Afternoon at leisure. (B)

Hotel: Paxton or similar

Day 11 Port Elizabeth • Knysna • Today you will visit the Tsitsikamma Forest. A short walk to the Storms River Mouth offers some magnificent views of the gorge and river below. Arrive in Knysna late afternoon. (B)

Hotel: Knysna Hollow or similar (2 nights)

Day 12 Knysna • Oudtshoorn • Knysna • Travel inland over the spectacular Outeniqua Pass to Oudtshoorn, known as the "feather capital of the world" because of its ostrich industry. Visit the famous Cango Caves and an Ostrich Farm where you have the opportunity of riding one of these giant birds. (B/D)

Day 13 Knysna • Cape Town • Travel to Cape Town via Mossel Bay to visit the famous Post Office Tree, the Bartholomew Diaz Museum and Shell Museum. We drive via Swellendam, Worcester and through the Huguenot Tunnel before arriving in Cape Town in the late afternoon. (B)

Hotel: Fountains or similar (2 nights)

Day 14 Cape Town • Full day Cape Point tour including visits of the Cape of Good Hope Reserve, Boulders Beach, Chapman's Peak, Hout Bay and Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens. (B)

Day 15 Cape Town • Transfer to Cape Town Airport. (B)
