Kenya is situated on Africa's east coast straddling the equator and sharing borders with Tanzania to the south. Tanzania, the biggest of the East African countries, lies on the coast of the warm Indian Ocean. These beautiful countries have a diverse range of activities to choose from such as game drives in national parks or balloon safaris over the Masai Mara or Serengeti.

**Day 1 Nairobi** • Arrival in Nairobi transfer to your hotel.  
*Hotel: Nairobi Safari Club (2 nights)*

**Day 2 Nairobi** • Morning city tour of Nairobi including visits of Karen Blixen museum and Giraffe center. Lunch at Karen Blixen Coffee Garden. In the evening, welcome dinner at the world famous restaurant "The Carnivore". (B/L/D)

**Day 3 Nairobi • Masai Mara** • Departure for the most famous natural reserve of Kenya, Masai Mara. The red-clad Masai warriors tend their herds of cattle amongst the wildlife, admirably unmoved by the presence of large predators. Arrive at the lodge in time for lunch and continue on an afternoon game drive. (B/L/D)  
*Hotel: Fig Tree Camp (2 nights)*

**Day 4 Masai Mara** • A full day in the Mara with morning and afternoon game drives in this spectacular game reserve. Game includes elephants, black rhinos, buffalos, lions, leopards and much more. During one of the game drives you will visit a Masai village. (B/L/D)  
*Optional: Balloon safari including picnic breakfast and champagne. (\$)*

**Day 5 Masai Mara • Lake Nakuru** • Depart towards the Great Rift Valley to Lake Nakuru, situated in the heart of one of Kenya's most densely animal populated wetland national parks. After lunch take an afternoon game drive. (B/L/D)  
*Hotel: Sarova Lion Hill Lodge (1 night)*

**Day 6 Lake Nakuru • Amboseli** • After breakfast, depart for Amboseli National Park, situated at the foot of the impressive snow-capped peak of Mt. Kilimanjaro, Africa's highest mountain at 19,340 feet. Game drive en route. (B/L/D)  
*Hotel: Kilima Safari Camp (2 nights)*

**Day 7 Amboseli** • Morning and afternoon game drives to view wildlife against the backdrop of Mt. Kilimanjaro. The park offers a wide variety of wildlife, but the principal attraction is its vast herds of elephants within the park. (B/L/D)

**Day 8 Amboseli • Ngorongoro** • After breakfast, transfer to Namanga boarder where you will board your Tanzania 4x4 safari vehicle. Drive to Arusha for lunch and continue to your lodge situated on the rim of the Ngorongoro crater. The crater covers over 250 square kilometers of land and is the home of the rare black rhino, prides of lion, elephant, cheetah and great herds of buffalo, antelope and wildebeest. (B/L/D)  
*Hotel: Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge (2 nights)*

**Day 9 Ngorongoro** • Descend 600 m to the floor of the crater for a half-day tour in a 4x4 vehicle. Explore the forest areas that are inhabited by monkey and elephant, the lake area where you may see flamingos and the open savannah where the lions hunt for food. In the afternoon, enjoy a guided walking safari along the crater rim. (B/L/D)

**Day 10 Ngorongoro • Serengeti** • After breakfast, drive to Olduvai Gorge, site of Louis and Mary Leakey's renowned archaeological discoveries. Their findings include some of man's earliest known ancestral remains. Continue to your lodge situated in the Serengeti National Park with a game drive en route in a 4x4 vehicle. (B/L/D)  
*Hotel: Serengeti Sopa Lodge (2 nights)*

**Day 11 Serengeti** • Morning and afternoon game drives in a 4x4 vehicle. This enormous park supports every variety of animals imaginable, from large predators such as lion, leopard and cheetah to the smaller herbivores they prey on. (B/L/D)

**Day 12 Serengeti • Lake Manyara** • Depart for Lake Manyara National Park. Arrive at your lodge in time for lunch. Afternoon game drive in a 4x4 vehicle in the park, famous for its prolific bird-life and other inhabitants such as hippos, monkeys, and tree climbing lions. (B/L/D)  
*Hotel: Kirurumu Tented Camp (1 night)*

**Day 13 Lake Manyara • Arusha** • Drive to Arusha, make a shopping stop at the Arusha cultural center before lunch. In the afternoon, transfer to Kilimanjaro airport. (B/L)
