Step out into the vast open plains of Tanzania and you suddenly feel very, very small. You have just joined one of the largest and wildest animal populations in the world. Wildebeest, monkey, antelope, lion, cheetah, crocodile, gazelle, and flamingo - they're all out there. Tanzania's famous parks offer some of the best wildlife spotting opportunities on the continent.

Day 1 Arusha • Upon arrival at Kilimanjaro International Airport, you will be welcomed and transferred to your hotel in Arusha.
Hotel: The Arusha Hotel (1 night)

Day 2 Arusha • Tarangire • After breakfast, drive to Tarangire National Park, famous for its vast numbers of the ancient baobab trees that first capture your eye. Arrive at your lodge for lunch followed by an afternoon game drive. (B/L/D)
Hotel: Tarangire Sopa Lodge / Tarangire River Camp (1 night)

Day 3 Tarangire • Ngorongoro • Drive through the Ngorongoro Highlands to your lodge situated on the rim of the crater. The crater covers over 250 square kilometers of land and is the home of the rare black rhino, prides of lion, elephant, cheetah and great herds of buffalo, antelope and wildebeest. In the afternoon, visit of a Masai village. (B/L/D)
Hotel: Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge / Ngorongoro Serena Lodge (2 nights)

Day 4 Ngorongoro • Today you will descend 600 m (over 2000 feet) to the floor of the crater for a half day crater tour. Explore the forest areas that are inhabited by monkeys and elephants, the lake area, where you may see flamingos and the open savannah where the lions hunt for food. Return to the lodge for lunch. In the afternoon, guided walking safari along the crater rim. (B/L/D)

Day 5 Ngorongoro • Serengeti • After breakfast drive to Olduvai Gorge, site of Louis and Mary Leakey's renowned archaeological discoveries. Their findings include some of the man's earliest known ancestral remains. Continue to Serengeti. This enormous park supports every variety of animal imaginable – from large predators such as lion, leopard and cheetah to the smaller herbivores they prey on. Late afternoon game drive. (B/L/D)
Hotel: Serengeti Sopa Lodge / Serengeti Serena Lodge (3 nights)

Day 6-7 Serengeti • Morning and afternoon game drives. More than two million wildebeest, Thompson's gazelle and zebra gather during the migration, attracting a great deal of attention from their predators such as lion, hyena, cheetah and leopard. (B/L/D)

Optional: Balloon safari including picnic breakfast and champagne (\$)

Day 8 Serengeti • Lake Manyara • Depart for Lake Manyara National Park. Lunch at your lodge, followed by an afternoon game drive in this park famous for its prolific bird-life and other inhabitants such as hippos, monkeys and tree climbing lions. (B/L/D)
Hotel: Kirurumu Tented Lodge / Lake Manyara Serena Lodge (1 night)

Day 9 Lake Manyara • Arusha • Drive back to Arusha. Make a shopping stop at the Arusha cultural center before proceeding for lunch. Transfer to your hotel where a dayroom has been reserved. In the evening, transfer to Kilimanjaro International Airport. (B/L)
Hotel: The Arusha Hotel (dayroom)
