If you don't have the time to travel to Ayers Rock or Alice Springs but still want to experience the "Outback" of Australia, you should consider a short journey to Broken Hill.

The unofficial capital of the NSW Outback, Broken Hill is known for its isolation as well as its rich silver deposits which were discovered in the late 1800's. More recently, Broken Hill with the vast skies, sun-seared rocks has inspired some of Australia's best known artists. About 10 km north of Broken Hill in the middle of the Living Desert Reserve is Sundown Hill, site of the Living Desert Sculptures.

The town of Silverton with a population of less than 70, has been the Sight of many films including A Town Like Alice and Mad Max II. The blood-red earth and sunsets, solitary stone buildings and camels in the main street have made it a favourite with visitors and filmmakers.

Less than 2 hours flight from Sydney is beautiful Lord Howe Island, a timeless natural paradise that will relax and revitalize you. Explore reefs teeming with rainbow-coloured fish, relax on unspoiled beaches, marvel at the flora found no where else on earth or climb the soaring mountains where magnificent seabirds nest in their thousands.

Lord Howe is one of only 4 island groups granted World Heritage status thanks to its remarkable volcanic geology, its exceptional range of ecosystems, its rare collection of birds and marine life and its exceptional beauty.

There are a number of walking itineraries that cover different parts of the island ranging from 2 to 3 hours to full day hikes. We would recommend the 7km Malabar Hill and Kims Lookout hike for it is spectacular views of the cliffs and ocean.

For those who prefer two wheels, bikes and helmets can be rented from most hotels and resorts. It is crucial if you want to travel to this stunning location that you book well in advance as there is a maximum of 400 visitors allowed on the island at any one time.
