Yarra Valley And Mornington Peninsula 5-Day Package

The Yarra Valley and the Mornington Peninsula are both noted Internationally for their fine wine, regional produce and luxury Country retreats. While the Mornington Peninsula is almost surrounded by the sea, much of the Yarra Valley and the Dandenong ranges are cloaked in beautiful forests.

DAY 1 • Melbourne to Rye – 80 kms

Join the Nepean Highway to Frankston and on to the Mornington Peninsula. Mornington Peninsula is arguably Melbourne’s best kept secret. It has much of Victoria’s earliest history, golf courses, restaurants and one of Australia’s finest wine producing regions. Sorrento/Portsea – attractions include the Marine aquarium. You can see seals being fed or take a cruise on Port Phillip Bay and swim with the dolphins. Overnight: One Four Nelson, Rye

DAY 2 • Explore the area with your Mornington Peninsula Attractions Pass which allows you entry into 4 of the icons of the area including admission at Point Nepean National Park and a ride on the Point Nepean Transporter with commentary.

DAY 3 • Rye to Cowes - 150 kms

Depart Rye to Cranbourne ; join the South Gippsland Highway to Phillip Island. At San Remo cross the bridge to Phillip Island, home of the fairy penguins that emerge from the surf at dusk. The island has a wildlife reserve with koalas, fur seals, pelicans and mutton-birds. The Ultimate Penguin Tour is included. Overnight: The Continental Hotel

DAY 4 • Phillip Island to Yarra Glen – 167 kms

The Yarra Valley is endowed with some of the most beautiful countryside in Victoria. The Healesville Sanctuary is home to Australian birds and animal like the platypus, koalas, Tasmanian devils and echidnas are included (Entrance fees included). You may want to visit one of the many vineyards for lunch and glass of wine. Overnight: Mercure Yarra Valley Balgownie Estate

DAY 5 • Yarra Glen to Melbourne – 48 kms

Drive back to Melbourne to return your car.

Great Ocean Road

5-Day Package

Travel one of the world’s most scenic roads through the Great Ocean Road region which covers south-west Victoria and is home to the famous 12 Apostles.

DAY 1 • Melbourne to Sovereign Hill – 115 kms

Ballarat is the main centre of the Victorian Central Highlands, the biggest attraction is Sovereign Hill, a theme park re-creating the old gold rush days. Its staff members dress in period costume, and it contains realistic stores and banks. Overnight: Sovereign Hill Lodge

DAY 2 • Ballarat – Halls Gap - 141 kms

Depart Ballarat and rejoin the Western Freeway traveling through Ararat to arrive at Halls Gap. Halls Gap is hidden in the heart of Australia’s most spectacular wilderness region. Overnight: Halls Gap Colonial Motor Inn

DAY 3 • Halls Gap – Port Fairy - 158 kms

Port Fairy is a delightful little fishing port and seaside resort at the mouth of the Moyne River it is one of the oldest settlements in Victoria. Overnight: Comfort Inn Port Fairy

DAY 4 • Port Fairy – Apollo Bay - 190 kms

Apollo Bay is a scenic little fishing port, boasting some magnificent beaches. Enjoy a 10 minute scenic helicopter flight over Port Campbell and the 12 Apostles. Overnight: Comfort Inn The International

DAY 5 • Apollo Bay – Melbourne - 195 kms

Drive back to Melbourne to return your car
