Fleurieu Peninsula And Kangaroo Island

4-Night Package

Less than 30 minutes drive from Adelaide, the Fleurieu Peninsula has rolling hills of vineyards, untouched bushland, stunning beaches and dramatic coastlines. Just a short ferry ride away is Kangaroo Island which is Australia's third largest island and renowned for its diversity and abundance of wildlife. Combine the two areas and you have a marvelous self-drive side trip.

DAY 1 • Adelaide to Victor Harbour – 100km

This coastal playground is famed for its laidback lifestyle, with a variety of water sports activities for every taste, quirky and quaint small coastal towns full of history and of course, the wineries. Depending what time you depart Adelaide you may wish to visit a few of the 70 cellar doors around McLaren Vale, Langhorne Creek or Currency Creek or maybe the beaches are of more interest – have a look at the beaches on the eastern coast of the peninsula on your drive down.

DAY 2 • Explore Victor Harbour and Goolwa

Your tour includes a full day Spirit Australia Cruise which Travel 30 kilometers into the pristine waters of Coorong National Park. Tour includes lunch and afternoon tea

DAY 3 • Victor Harbour to Kangaroo Island – 1h45 minutes

Cross from Cape Jervis to Kangaroo Island on the Sealink car and passenger ferry landing at Penneshaw. The Kangaroo Island Information Centre is located on Howard Drive in Penneshaw and they will be able to assist you with maps, directions and self-touring options

DAY 4 • Day at leisure

DAY 5 • Return to Adelaide

Today, you cross on the ferry again saying goodbye to Kangaroo Island and drive back to Adelaide to return your car.
