Day 1 Johannesburg • Upon arrival in Johannesburg you will be met and transferred to your hotel. Accommodation: Peermont Metcourt

Day 2 Johannesburg • Hazyview • Leave Johannesburg along the Panorama Route via View God's Window before heading to Hazyview. Accommodation: Hippo Hollow for 2 nights. (B/D)

Day 3 Hazyview • Kruger National Park • Hazyview • Full day game viewing in order to enjoy the wonders of exploring the Kruger National Park in your closed vehicle. Optional (\$): Open safari vehicle game drive. Reservation and payment at destination. (B)

Day 4 Hazyview • Swaziland • Depart on your journey to Swaziland. Visit the famous Ngwenya Glass Factory before arriving at the hotel. Accommodation: Lugogo Sun. (B)

Day 5 Swaziland • St Lucia • Depart towards the region of KwaZulu-Natal. Afternoon Sundowner cruise on St Lucia Lake with the opportunity of sighting hippos, crocodiles and bird life. Accommodation: Protea Hotel Umfolozi. (B)

Day 6 St Lucia • Durban • Departure towards Durban. On arrival, city centre orientation tour and visit of the Botanical Garden. Accommodation: Tropicana. Optional (\$): Early morning open safari vehicle game drive in Hluhluwe-Umfolozi Park. Reservation and payment at destination. (B/D)

Day 7 Durban • Drakensberg • Head into the majestic Southern Drakensberg Mountains where you will visit the Howick Falls. Arriving at the hotel mid-afternoon. Accommodation: Drakensberg Gardens for 2 nights. (B/D)

Day 8 Drakensberg • Full day at leisure. Optional (\$): 4x4 Adventure tour up Sani Pass and into Lesotho (passport required). Reservation and payment at destination. (B/D)

Day 9 Drakensberg • East London • Departure towards East London with a stop in Umtata, where Nelson Mandela was born and grew up. Accommodation: Kennaway. (B)

Day 10 East London • Port Elizabeth • Short orientation tour of East London. Continue towards Grahamstown and visit the 1820 Settler Memorial before continuing onto Port Elizabeth. Afternoon at leisure. Accommodation: Paxton. (B)

Day 11 Port Elizabeth • Knysna • Today you will visit the Tsitsikamma Forest. A short walk to the Storms River Mouth offers some magnificent views of the gorge and river below. Arrive in Knysna late afternoon. Accommodation: Knysna Hollow for 2 nights. (B)

Day 12 Knysna • Oudtshoorn • Knysna • Travel inland over the spectacular Outeniqua Pass to Oudtshoorn. Visit the famous Cango Caves and an Ostrich Farm where you have the opportunity of riding one of these giant birds. (B/D)

Day 13 Knysna • Cape Town • Travel to Cape Town via Mossel Bay. Accommodation: Protea Hotel Seapoint for 2 nights. (B)

Day 14 Cape Town • Full day Cape Point tour including visits of the Cape of Good Hope Reserve, Boulders Beach, Chapman's Peak, Hout Bay and Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens. (B)

Day 15 Cape Town • Transfer to Cape Town Airport. (B)
