Day 1 Nairobi • Transfer to your hotel.
Accommodation: Nairobi Safari Club: 2 nights

Day 2 Nairobi • Morning City Tour. Lunch at Karen Blixen Coffee Garden. Dinner The Carnivore. (B/L/D)

Day 3 Nairobi • Masai Mara • Departure for the most famous natural reserve in Kenya, the Masai Mara. Accommodation: Fig Tree Camp: 2 nights. (B/L/D)

Day 4 Masai Mara • Full day in the Mara with morning and afternoon game drives in this spectacular game reserve.

Day 5 Masai Mara • Lake Nakuru • Depart towards the Gerar Rift Valley to Lake Nakuru.
Accommodation: Sarova Lion Hill Lodge. (B/L/D)

Day 8 Amboseli • Ngorongoro • After breakfast, transfer to Namanga border where you will board your Tanzania 4 x 4 safari vehicle. Drive to Arusha for lunch and continue to your lodge situated on the rim of the Ngorongoro crater. Accommodation: Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge for 2 nights. (B/L/D)

Day 9 Ngorongoro • Descend 600 m to the floor of the crater for a half-day tour in 4 x 4 vehicle. (B/L/D)

Day 10 Ngorongoro • Serengeti • After breakfast, drive to Olduvai Gorge, site of Mary Leakey's renowned archaeological discoveries. Accommodation: Serengeti Sopa Lodge for 2 nights. (B/L/D)

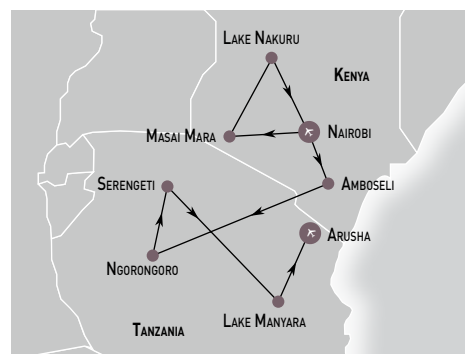
Day 11 Serengeti • Morning and afternoon game drives. This enormous park support every variety of animal imaginable. (B/L/D)

Day 12 Serengeti • Lake Manyara • Depart for Lake Manyara National Park. Lake Manyara is famous for its prolific bird life and other inhabitants such as tree climbing lions. Accommodation: Kirurumu Tented Camp. (B/L/D)

Day 13 Lake Manyara • Arusha • Drive to Arusha, make a shopping stop at the Arusha cultural centre. Transfer to Kilimanjaro airport. (B/L)
