



AFRICA AT YOUR FINGERTIPS
AMBOSELI, TANZANIA AND ZANZIBAR
12 DAYS / 11 NIGHTS / 32 MEALS

A perfect tour to explore the best of Kenya and Tanzania and to finish in style, a few days to enjoy the charm of the "spice island".

ITINERARY

DAY 1 NAIROBI

Upon arrival at Nairobi Airport, our guide will be waiting for you in the arrival hall carrying a branded sign board. Meet and greet and transfer to your hotel.

Accommodation: Hotel Jacaranda or similar

DAY 2 NAIROBI · AMBOSELI

Breakfast. Morning at leisure. Lunch. Drive from Nairobi to Amboseli. Approximate journey time 4,5 hours. Diner at the lodge. (B/L/D)

Accommodation: Sentrim Amboseli or similar for 2 nights

DAY 3 AMBOSELI

Breakfast. Discover the Amboseli National Park. The ecosystem of this low rainfall region depends on water from Mount Kilimanjaro (5895 m). A particular feature of Amboseli is the possibility to take picture postcard photos of elephants against the backdrop of Kilimanjaro. Covering an area of 392 km² the park is, in addition to elephants, home to numerous animals (giraffe, wildebeest, antelope, buffalo, lion, cheetah, leopard and hyena ...) as well as 400 species of birds (pelicans, kingfishers, crakes, hamerkop and 47 types of raptor) who live alongside the Masai villages. Before the main heat of the day, go on a safari in the park which is famous for its high concentration of elephant. They appear most often in troops lead by an old female. You will have the best chances of spotting them at watering holes. Picnic lunch. Guided afternoon game drive through the Amboseli National Park. From Observation Hill you will have a view of the entire park and especially the swamp areas where buffalo, elephants, hippos and a diversity of water birds come to cool off and refresh themselves. Look out for the shy porcupine who only dares to emerge at sunset. Dinner at the lodge. (B/L/D)

DAY 4 AMBOSELI · ARUSHA

Breakfast. Before the main heat of the day, go on a safari in the park which is famous for its high concentration of elephant. They appear most often in troops lead by an old female. You will have the best chances of spotting them at watering holes. Lunch. Drive from Amboseli to Namanga located on the border of Kenya and Tanzania. Transfer from Namanga to Arusha. Dinner at the lodge. (B/L/D)

Accommodation: Ilboru Safari Lodge or similar

DAY 5 ARUSHA · NGORONGORO KARATU

Breakfast. Drive from Arusha to Manyara. Morning game drive in the Lake Manyara National Park. This small yet fantastically diverse park is rewarding for anyone who visits it, from bird lovers to nature enthusiasts and Big Five seekers. Your early start will be worth it as you stop to admire the sun rising over Lake Manyara, a large alkaline lake covering a third of the park and home to over 400 species of birds. Here you will find flamingos in their thousands during the rainy season and many varieties of water birds and other migrant species. Admire the theatrical western escarpment of the Great Rift Valley as well as hot springs and lush forest as you come across elephant, buffalo, zebra, giraffe, baboon and monkey. Manyara is also awash with predators and your morning game drive may coincide with a leopard or hyena returning from their hunt while tree-climbing lions could be spotted enjoying the fruits of their efforts high up in the safety of a tree. Picnic lunch. Drive from Manyara to Ngorongoro. Dinner at the lodge. (B/L/D)

Accommodation: Bougainvillea Safari Lodge or similar

DAY 6 NGORONGORO KARATU · SERENGETI SERONERA

Breakfast. Drive from Ngorongoro to the Serengeti. Picnic lunch. The Serengeti National Park is home to a considerable wildlife population in all seasons: gazelles, antelopes, giraffes, buffalos, zebras, jackals, warthogs, monkeys ... all are gathered here. Elephants, hippos, crocodiles are also among the main residents of the park. Over 500 species of birds have been identified including ostriches, bustards and secretary birds. The park is also famous for its many predators: more than a thousand lions, hundreds of cheetahs, many hyenas and some leopards have been recorded. Afternoon game drive. (B/L/D)

Accommodation: Thorn Tree Camp or similar for 2 nights

DAY 7 SERENGETI SERONERA

Breakfast. Morning and afternoon game drive in the Serengeti National Park. Dinner at the camp. (B/L/D)

DAY 8 SERENGETI SERONERA · NGORONGORO KARATU

Breakfast. Drive from the Serengeti to Ngorongoro. Picnic lunch. Discover the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. Initially incorporated into the Serengeti National Park, the Area is not a National Park. It was founded in 1959,

following a conflict between the National Parks and the Maasai, as a nature reserve to protect a unique wildlife but also as a haven for the Maasai. Cut across one of Africa's wildlife hotspots on an afternoon game drive in the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. This stunning piece of wilderness is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, located within the crater highlands of Tanzania and covering vast expanses of highland plains, savannah woodlands and forests. Within it lies the Ngorongoro Crater, the world's largest volcanic caldera housing dense wildlife species of global importance due to the large presence of internationally threatened species such as black rhino. If during your safari expeditions you have not yet come across a lion, Ngorongoro will not disappoint as it holds the highest density of this predator in the world. Dinner at the lodge. (B/L/D)

Accommodation: Country Lodge or similar

DAY 9 NGORONGORO KARATU · ARUSHA · ZANZIBAR

Breakfast. Drive from Ngorongoro to Arusha. Picnic lunch. Transfer to the airport for your flight to Zanzibar Island. Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel. (B/L/D)

Accommodation: Dreams Bay or similar, for 3 nights

DAYS 10-11 ZANZIBAR

Days at leisure. (B/L/D)

DAY 12 ZANZIBAR DEPARTURE

Breakfast. Picnic lunch. Transfer to Zanzibar Airport. (B/L)
