WHISTLER

ZIPLINE ADVENTURE - BEAR TOUR (2.5 hours)

Ride on a series of cables and suspension bridges, and explore the hidden beauty of Fitzsimmons Creek and the picturesque forest valley between Whistler and Blackcomb Mountains. This tour is perfect for families and those who have never ziplined before.

MOUNTAIN EXPLORER ATV TOUR (2 hours)

Take a guided ride on an All-Terrain Vehicle (ATV) through the Hidden Valley between Whistler and Blackcomb Mountains. Experience spectacular views of the surrounding valleys, glacier peaks, forest canopy and the unique local wildlife.

PEAK 2 PEAK GONDOLA (Admission)

Spanning the distance between Whistler and Blackcomb Mountains, the Guinness World Record-breaking PEAK 2 PEAK Gondola provides an unparalleled perspective of British Columbia's rooftop providing incomparable views of towering volcanic peaks, coastal rainforests, and ancient glaciers.

ULTIMATE GLACIER TOUR (40 minutes)

Participants soar above Whistler and surrounding area, taking in breathtaking scenery and commentary provided by an experienced pilot. Highlights include Garibaldi Park Glaciers and lake, Whistler Village, Blackcomb Mountain, and Whistler's backcountry.

WHISTLER HIDDEN GEMS TOUR (3 hours)

This 4-course dinner tour explores four local favourite restaurants, a chocolate shop and a local brewhouse. The tour features such delicacies as a beer flight tasting, pan-seared salmon over a bed of fresh vegetables, prawns and a 6-hour slow roast lamb with rice and vegetables. Menu may change according to season.



TOFINO

TOFINO WHALEWATCHING CRUISE BY COVERED BOAT OR ZODIAC (2.5 hours)

View grey whales, humpback whales, transient orcas and a myriad of other marine life and discover the beauty of Clayoquot Sound on the west coast of Vancouver Island. You will ride aboard the 65' Leviathan II. This vessel offers heated indoor and outdoor seating, washrooms, snack bar and a fully-licensed bar. This spacious vessel offers superb viewing from the upper and lower decks along with commentary by experienced and knowledgeable crew, including certified naturalists. You can also choose a trip on a 29' rigid hull, inflatable Zodiac.

HOT SPRINGS ADVENTURE INCLUDING FLOATPLANE (5 hours)

Board a 9-metre covered cabin cruiser and travel through the heart of Clayoquot Sound to Hot Springs Cove for a 3-hour stopover to relax in the natural, thermal springs. The 30-minute scenic walk to and from the springs is along a boardwalk through ancient rainforest. The tour ends with a scenic 20-minute flight departing from the hot springs and ending in Tofino.

DISCOVER THE RAINFOREST KAYAK & HIKE (4 hours)

Embark on a 2.5-hour kayaking excursion through the sparkling waters of Clayoquot Sound. Arrive at Meares Island where you will continue your journey on a 1.5-hour guided hike along the Big Tree Trail and explore the island's ancient temperate rainforest. Stand in awe amongst the 1,000 -1,500 year old red cedar trees and learn more about the local ecology and captivating First Nations history.

BEARWATCHING IN TOFINO BY COVERED BOAT (2.5 hours)

At low tide, board a 14-metre Panoramic View Cruiser and speed along the lush Vancouver Island coastline to the feeding grounds of the elusive black bear. When the tide goes out, the bears emerge from the forests and forage along the shores in search of rock crabs. These times offer excellent opportunities to view the inquisitive animals in their natural habitat.



CALGARY

DOWNTOWN INTRO WALKING TOUR (2 hours)

Discover what makes Calgary such an exciting place on this walking tour. The tour will introduce the city's history, public art, sculptures, restaurants, +15 system and more!

CALGARY TOWER ADMISSION

Located 191 meters above the downtown core, the Calgary Tower observation deck offers a spectacular 360° view of the city, the majestic Rocky Mountains, the rolling foothills, and the expansive prairie landscape. Stand on the amazing glass floor before your tour to learn about Calgary's history, landmarks, and future plans for the city.

HERITAGE PARK HISTORICAL VILLAGE - ADMISSION

Heritage Park is Canada's largest living history museum, with hundreds of exhibits, rides, shops, restaurants, a thundering steam train, antique midway rides, beautifully preserved heritage buildings, daily demonstrations and activities to keep the young and the young-at-heart captivated.

NATIONAL MUSIC CENTRE - STUDIO BELL ADMISSION

Explore 5 floors of interactive exhibitions on a journey through the sights, sounds and stories of music in Canada. Inspired by music festivals, Studio Bell is designed to activate all of the senses - play the guitar, mix a track, sing along in vocal booths, and explore memorabilia from Canadian music icons and take a walk through four Canadian Music Halls of Fame.

XPLORING CALGARY BUS TOUR (3 hours)

View the sites of Calgary's modern urban centre. Points of interest include Canada Olympic Park, Lougheed House, Stampede Park, Downtown Calgary, and more. Various photo opportunities are available.

VINTAGE SIDECAR MOTORCYCLE TOUR – CITY OF CALGARY SIGHTSEEING (1 hour)

Wind your way through historic locations, across the mighty Bow River; and explore scenic Eau Claire, Kensington and Inglewood districts, stopping for photos along the way. Enjoy Calgary from a totally unique perspective. Included are driver\guide with live commentary, helmet, rain ponchos (if required), sheepskins and bottled water.



BANFF

COWBOY COOKOUT LUNCH (3 hours)

Enjoy an afternoon in the great outdoors on this true western excursion. Horseback riders travel along the trail at the base of Sulphur Mountain, and non-riders enjoy a scenic covered-wagon ride along the Bow River. Everyone meets up for a BBQ steak cookout at 3 Mile Cabin by the Sundance Canyon Trail. After lunch, return to Banff.

HORSESHOE CANYON RAFTING (4 hours)

A half-day whitewater tour that offers adventure lovers spectacular scenery, rafting thrills and excitement on the Horseshoe Canyon section of the class III – IV Bow River. Experience a sense of remoteness while you raft your way through shale canyons and awesome whitewater up to Grade IV.

BANFF GONDOLA RIDE (2 hours)

A breathtaking ascent to the pinnacle of Sulphur Mountain for an awe-inspiring 360-degree panorama of sheer mountain majesty. Enjoy the interpretative hiking trails that lead along the ridge of the mountain. After an invigorating hike why not enjoy one of the two excellent restaurants at the summit.

SIGNATURE HIKE (7 hours)

Share your passion for the mountains with local guides and take a hike to classic locations in the Banff and Lake Louise area. Explore the trails in Yoho National Park, Larch Valley, Stanley Glacier and the Plain of 6 Glaciers. Tour includes hotel transfers and a hearty packed lunch with choice of sandwich.

BANFF LAKE CRUISE (LAKE MINNEWANKA) (1 hour)

This interpretive boat tour of magnificent Lake Minnewanka will immerse you in a rugged wilderness steeped in history, Aboriginal folklore and geology. Nestled in the heart of Banff National Park, Lake Minnewanka offers some of the most interesting and spectacular scenery found anywhere in the Canadian Rockies.

VIA FERRATA: EXPLORER ROUTE (2hours)

Led by a certified guide, climbers make their way up the cliffs above the Banff Mt Norquay ski area, guided by a series of cables, fixed anchors and ladders. Highlights include an open air chairlift ride, climbing a rock face, viewing boardwalk and sightseeing platform. No climbing experience is necessary. This excursion is a Signature Experience with Destination Canada.



JASPER

WILDLIFE DISCOVERY TOUR (3.5 hours)

Explore the magnificent Maligne Valley and discover striking natural beauty, abundant wildlife and a genuine geological mystery. You are likely to see bald eagles, big horn sheep, elk, deer and bears en route to view a spectacular 50-metre gorge and Medicine Lake.

SPIRIT ISLAND CRUISE ON MALIGNE LAKE (1.5 hours)

This scenic tour is operated in a glass-enclosed, heated cruise boat and is fully narrated by a Transport Canada licensed crew. Mid-way through the cruise there is a stop at Spirit Island where passengers disembark for a short walk to the lookout point - a wonderful photo opportunity not to be missed!

EXPLORE JASPER (7 hours, or 8.5 hours with cruise)

Explore the spectacular natural treasures of the largest national park in the Canadian Rockies. Stand above the massive walls of Maligne Canyon for stunning views of rushing waterfalls, discover the mystery of the disappearing water at Medicine Lake and experience a scenic cruise (seasonal) on Maligne Lake. Light snacks and refreshments, and a hot lunch are included.

JASPER MOTORCYCLE TOUR (2 hours)

From the freedom of the sidecar of a powerful Harley-Davidson touring motorcycle driven by a professional rider, view the world famous resorts, beautiful lakes, historical sites, view points, and attractions of the Jasper area. Full leather gear including a heated vest is provided. One or three-hour tours are also available.

WHITE WATER RAFTING TOUR (2.5 hours)

Marvel at the incomparable views of Jasper National Park with a Parks Canada licensed guide on the Athabasca River. Travelling approximately 9-kilometres, the tour traverses a series of Class 2 white water rapids while a guide provides commentary on the local community and geological history during the calm stretches. Wet suits, neoprene booties and life jackets are provided.

JASPER DOWNTOWN FOODIE TOUR (3 hours)

A guided 1.5 km walk over 3 hours where you will be visiting four restaurants and tasting four carefully handpicked dishes, each paired with an alcoholic beverage. Along the way you will learn about Jasper's history and taking in some of the town's best tales.

OTTAWA

ADMISSION TO CANADIAN MUSEUM OF HISTORY AND WAR MUSEUM

Take a guided tour of one of the Museum of History's four permanent galleries or a Grand Tour highlighting the essential displays of the Museum. Audio guides are also available for rent for the Grand Hall and the First Peoples Hall. The Canadian Postal Museum, the popular Canadian Children's Museum and an IMAX theatre are also on site. Additionally, the Canadian War Museum showcases exhibitions that illustrate the way in which human conflicts, in Canada and around the globe, have changed the face of the world.

OTTAWA EXPRESS BICYCLE TOUR (2 hours)

Starting downtown, this leisurely ride will travel on the Rideau Canal pathway, continuing to the Locks, the Fletcher Wild Life Garden and Arboreum, ending with a short visit in the Parliament area.

HISTORICAL HIGHLIGHTS WALKING TOUR (2 hours)

This leisurely sightseeing tour with a private guide providing a great overview of the city and showcases its colourful history, political characters and architecture. Included are stops at Parliament Hill, The National War Memorial, Sparks Street, Major's Hill Park, The Fairmont Chateau Laurier, Sussex Drive, The Rideau Canal, The Prime Minister's offices, ByWard Market and many more!



QUEBEC CITY

GUIDED CRUISE (1.5 hours)

See Canada's oldest city from the deck of a cruise boat on the St. Lawrence River with commentary. Relax and take in the spectacular views of the Chateau Frontenac, Cap Diamant, Ile d'Orleans and Montmorency Falls.

QUÉBEC CITY TOUR #1 (2 hours)

The tour provides a comprehensive orientation of historic and modern Québec City. You will see the Latin Quarter, the Plains of Abraham, the Citadel, the Fortifications, the National Assembly, Place Royale, the Basilica and other points of interest within Québec City. This tour is in English and French.

WHALE WATCHING TO BAIE STE-CATHERINE (11 hours)

A scenic transfer takes participants through the Charlevoix Region and onto Baie-Ste-Catherine for an exciting whale watching cruise. On the 3 hour cruise, a naturalist guide will help passengers learn more about the beluga and finback whale environment, underwater marine life and the majestic Saguenay Fjord.

IMMERSION QUÉBEC (1 hour)

Through interactive installations, games on a giant screen and virtual reality, participants will discover the historical events that made Québec such a unique city in North America. An unforgettable experience combining history, culture and entertainment.

GUIDED BICYCLE TOUR QUÉBEC – LOWER TOWN AND OLD PORT (2.5 hours - English)

Discover the hidden charms of the Lower Town and the Old Port of Quebec City on this enjoyable, eco-friendly bike tour. Access the area along the waterfront before turning up the small streets of the Lower Town. A stop in the Royal Square is made before continuing along St. Lawrence River to the Cap Diamant district.
