

**SAPA**  
4 DAYS / 3 NIGHTS



Sapa is a breathtaking hill town in North Vietnam near the Chinese border. This is home to stunning mountain landscapes, verdant rice terraces, unique stilt villages, different hill tribe minorities and exceptional views. Once there, you'll easily understand what the hype is all about.

## ITINERARY

### **DAY 1 HANOI – SA PA (300 KMS)**

Pick up from your hotel or airport and transfer by car to Sapa.

**Accommodation: Victoria Sapa Resort for 3 nights**

### **DAY 2 SA PA**

Leave Sa Pa at about 08.30am by vehicle and travel southwards to Sa Pa. The first 16km portion of the road offers spectacular landscapes of Hoang Lien mountain range, Fansipan peak as well as marvelous terraced rice fields of the Muong Hoa valley. Enjoy several photo stops before arriving to Su Pan Commune where customers will pay a visit to Hoa Su Pan, a small hamlet of the Black Hmong for half an hour. Continue the trip along the road further south to Muong Bo valley of Thanh Phu commune. Walk along the large village path for nearly an hour, visiting several homes of the Tai people who live in spacious houses built on stilts, witnessing their daily life and experiencing their hospitality. Lunch break in a local home. Continue the trip in the afternoon with a short drive along the rocky road to My Son and spend a half an hour to walk around this charming village of the Xa Pho ethnicity (whose population is only more than 6 thousand people) for a brief understanding of their very unique culture and custom. Then travel further to Nam Cang commune for visiting a beautiful and prosperous village of the Red Dao people in Nam Than village. This portion of the road trip offers beautiful scenery of the Nam Sai Valley. Leave Nam Cang in mid-afternoon and drive back along the same way to Sa Pa. (B/L)

### **DAY 3 SA PA (walking trek)**

Put your walking shoes on and descend into the valley of rice terraces! Visit ethnic hill tribes including Hmong and Giay, while enjoying the spectacular scenery. Pass through Heaven's Gate today! Tram Ton Pass is also known as Heaven's Gate as it's the highest mountain pass in Vietnam. From the dizzying heights we can look down over swirling clouds and deep green valleys. Take a break from the twisty roads to visit Silver Waterfall which cascades down from a height of 100 meters. (B)

### **DAY 4 SA PA - HANOI (300 KMS)**

By vehicle from Sa Pa to Hanoi (Noi Bai airport)...Approximate drive time is 5.5-6hrs (B)
